For questions 16 to 20, read the passage and answer the questions that follow.

Grey whales are found in the coastal waters of the North Pacific, mainly along the west coast of Canada, the United States, and Mexico. They are also found in small numbers in the near-shore waters of eastern Russia and Japan.

Grey whales feed on a variety of small crustaceans, including larval crabs and mysid shrimps. They also feed on small clams in shallow, muddy bays or fish larvae in the water column, but their most common prey are small, flea-like crustaceans called amphipods. Grey whales are mostly bottom feeders, but they can also feed in mid-water or near the surface, where they find amphipods. Grey whales can leave trails or furrows in the sediment where they have been feeding. A grey whale can eat as much as 1,200 kg of food a day. Interestingly, over 90% of grey whales showed a preference for rolling onto their right sides while they feed under water.

The most frequent predators of grey whales, particularly calves, are killer whales. Many grey whales have killer whale tooth rake scars and disfigurements on their bodies, particularly on their tails. Attacks are not always fatal, but pods of killer whales regularly attack, kill, and consume grey whales, especially calves, on migration as well as in summer feeding areas.

Like all whales and dolphins, grey whales are exposed to accidental entanglement in fishing gear. Western grey whale feeding grounds are also situated in important oil and gas fields off the coast of Russia. There is great concern about the **potential** impacts of oil and gas exploration and production on their population.
