PUBLIC SPEAKING COMPETITION

The Department of English conducted the Public Speaking Competition for students of Grade IV in the month of November, which culminated into a spectacular finale just before school closed for its winter break in December 2020.

The year 2020 being the first of all kinds conducted its first-ever Virtual Public Speaking Competition which aimed to encourage students to put forth their ideas confidently and help groom themselves into eloquent orators. This initiative taken by The Department of English encouraged and motivated every student from grade IV to come forth to present their views and let go of their stage fear thereby promoting linguistic competency.

All the students from each section of class IV were screened during the week-long Preliminary or Qualifying Round starting from 18th November 2020 onwards. The students displayed commendable confidence and impressive articulation in order to move ahead into the Final Round.

The Finalists from each section were then asked to send their recorded videos which were adjudged by their teachers on the merit of intonation, expression, content and fluency. The result of this Final Round was declared on the 10th of December 2020. The top-scorers from each section were felicitated with Certificates of Merit for their commendable performance.
