## **Subject-Verb Agreement**



What is Subject-Verb Agreement?

The subject-verb agreement simply means the subject and verb must agree in number.

For example: A scientist discovers new facts.



Scientists discover new facts.





The subject and verb must agree in number: both must be singular, or both must be plural.

### Singular subjects take singular verbs; plural subjects take plural verbs.



- 2. The number of the subject (singular or plural) is not changed by words (or a phrase) that come in between the subject and the verb.
  - ✓ One of my friends *is* sick.
  - $\checkmark$  One of the boxes *is* open.



- 3. Some subjects always take a singular verb even though the meaning may seem plural.
  - ✓ Someone in the game *was* (not were) hurt.

# These subjects always take singular verbs:

Each, either, neither, one, no one, everyone, someone, anyone, nobody, somebody, anybody, everybody

- 4. The following words may be singular or plural, depending upon their use in a sentence: some, any, all, most.
  - ✓ Most of the news <u>is</u> good.
  - ✓ Most of the flowers <u>were</u> red.
- 5. Subjects joined by "and" are plural. Subjects joined by "or" take a verb that agrees with the last subject.
  - ✓ Bob and George <u>are</u> leaving.
  - ✓ Neither Hari nor Ravi was present.

When two subjects are joined by 'as well as', the verb agrees with the first subject.


6. "There" and "here" are never subjects. In sentences that begin with these words, the subject

is usually found later on in the sentence.

✓ Here *comes* the trained elephant.




- ✓ There  $\underline{are}$  five books on the table.
- 7. Collective nouns may be singular or plural, depending on their use in the sentence.
  - ✓ The committee *was* formed in 2012.
  - ✓ The committee <u>are</u> having sandwiches for lunch.





✓ Physics <u>is</u> (not are) taught by Prof. Snape.



- ✓ The Gulliver Travels is a very interesting book.
- 9. Expressions of time, money, measurement, and weight are usually singular when the amount is considered one unit.
  - ✓ Ten dollars <u>is</u> a high price to pay.



- ✓ Five years  $\underline{is}$  the maximum sentence for that offence.
- 10. 'Doesn't' is a contraction of "does not" and should be used only with a singular subject. 'Don't' is a contraction of "do not" and should be used only with a plural subject.
  - ✓ He <u>doesn't</u> (not don't) know how to sail.



✓ They <u>don't</u> (not doesn't) like it.
