Transitive Verb

- Transitive verbs are action verbs that have an object to receive that action.
- I <u>bake</u> some cookies.
- I <u>ride</u> the bicycle.
- I move the chair.

Intransitive Verb

- Intransitive verbs are action verbs but unlike transitive verbs, they do not have an object receiving the action.
- I laugh.
- I cry.
- The book falls.
