6	Who is an archaeologist? <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Archaeologists are the persons who study the objects of the past.➤ They study the remains of the buildings made of stone and brick, paintings and sculpture.➤ They also explore and dig the earth in order to find out tools, weapons, pots, pans, ornaments and coins.
7	What is the difference between Inscriptions and Manuscripts? <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Inscriptions are writings on relatively hard surfaces like stone or metal.➤ Manuscript is hand-written matter on Palm leaf or the bark of the birch tree.
8	. What are the different ways to find about the past? <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Manuscripts: These were hand-written matter. They were usually written on palm leaf or the bark of the birch tree. These books dealt with all kinds of subjects such as religious beliefs and practices, the lives of kings, medicines and science. These manuscripts also included epics, poems, plays.➤ Inscriptions: are writings on relatively hard surfaces such as stone or metal. Some inscriptions kept records of victories in battle.➤ Archaeological excavations or evidences: Archaeology means the study of cultures of the past and of periods of history by examining the remains of buildings and objects found in the earth.
