Story Writing



A Story is a work of fiction or imagination that is usually written in easily understandable grammatical structure with natural flow of speech.

TITLE OF THE STORY

SPACE

PARAGRAPH 1

- **The introduction or beginning of the story** (set up the action/plot, gives background of the story or builds in a way that grabs the attention.)

SPACE

PARAGRAPH 2

- **Incidents and events are explained in detail** (logically presented in a sequential manner)

SPACE

PARAGRAPH 3

- **Conclusion** (climax- happy or sad ending)

SPACE

MORAL/ WORDS OF WISDOM/ QUOTE

POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. Give a suitable title and it should be as short as possible.
2. Introduce the main character and setting (time and location) in the beginning.
3. Develop suspense and action through a sequence of events in chronological order (with a clear beginning, middle and end).
4. Introduce monologue, dialogue or conversation (at least 3) in the story; but be careful to make it interesting and natural.
5. Provide a suitable moral in the end.

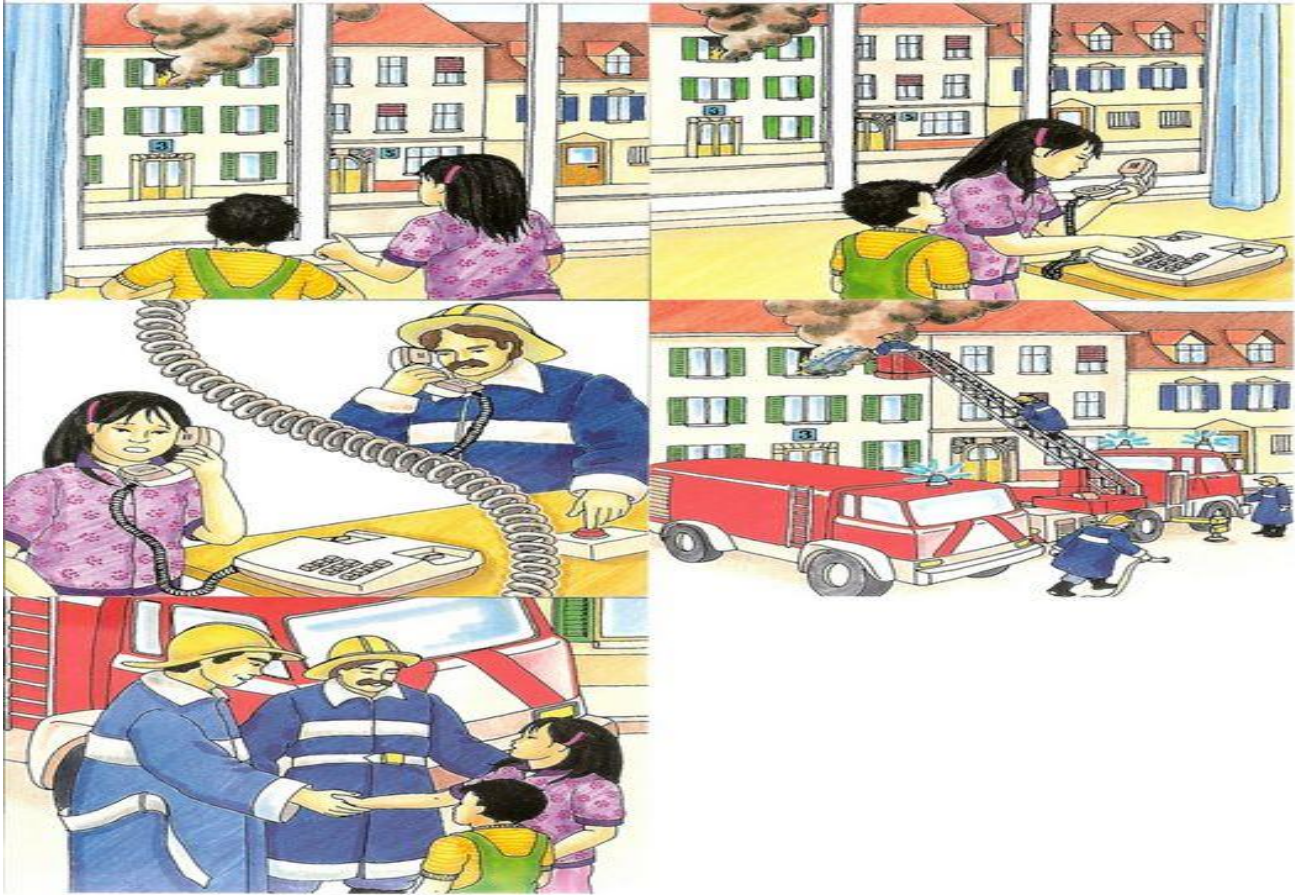


USE PAST TENSE WHILE WRITING THE STORY
