• The introduction or beginning of the story (set up the action/plot, gives background of the story or builds in a way that grabs the attention.)

• Incidents and events are explained in detail (logically presented in a sequential manner)

• Conclusion (climax- happy or sad ending)

MORAL/ WORDS OF WISDOM/ QUOTE

POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. Give a suitable title and it should be as short as possible.
- 2. Introduce the main character and setting (time and location) in the beginning.
- 3. Develop suspense and action through a sequence of events in chronological order (with a clear beginning, middle and end).
- 4. Introduce monologue, dialogue or conversation (at least 3) in the story; but be careful to make it interesting and natural.
- 5. Provide a suitable moral in the end.


