






- Used for objects that are not specific or one of several things of a similar type
 - E.g. I need a phone.
- Used the first time we introduce an object
- E.g. I saw a movie last night.
- Used as synonyms for the number one
- E.g. They bought a computer.
- Used to indicate one of a group
- E.g. She is a singer.



- E.g. Can you give me the books on the table?
 - Used when we mention the object again
- E.g. The movie is based on a real-life incident.
 - Used before plural countries or other plural regions and bodies of water
 - **E.g. The Netherlands**
 - Used before certain adjectives to give a plural meaning
 - E.g. The rich
