



## **Articles:**

An article is a word that modifies or describes the Noun. It is used before the noun to show whether it refers to something specific or not.

There are two types of articles: definite and indefinite.



We use a/an - the indefinite article - when we talk about something for the first time, or something that is part of a group or type.

I saw **a** good film yesterday. Do you want **a** drink?

We use a when the word that follows it begins with a consonant sound. We use an when it's followed by a vowel sound. This makes pronunciation easier.

She has **a** university degree. It took me **an** hour to get home.

We use the - the definite article - when the listener already knows which thing we are talking about because it was mentioned before or because there's only one of them.

I'm going to take **the** dog for a walk. Have you seen **the** car key? They go to **the** school next to **the** bridge.

When we talk about things in general, we normally use a plural or uncountable noun with no article.

Birds eat worms. Water freezes at 0°C. Children need a lot of sleep.

No article for continents, most countries, cities, towns, lakes, mountains or universities.
