- 3. I <u>am reading</u> a very interesting historical account. (Present Continuous Tense)
- 4. We generally <u>sing</u> songs all together. (Simple Present Tense)
- 5. We <u>go</u> to a gallery every Sunday. (Simple Present Tense)
- 6. <u>Does he write</u> an email? (Simple Present Tense)
- 7. I have been writing letters since 10 o'clock today. (Present Perfect Continuous Tense)
- 8. The Earth <u>moves</u> around the Sun. (Simple Present Tense)
