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Describe the various types of maps.

- ▶ Maps are of various types.
- ▶ They are physical maps, political maps and thematic maps
- ▶ Physical Maps show natural features of the Earth like mountains, plateaus, plains, rivers, oceans etc.
- ▶ Example: Physical map of the world.
- ▶ Political Maps show different countries and states of the world with their boundaries.
- ▶ Example: Political map of India.
- ▶ Thematic maps show specific information are called thematic maps. Example: Road maps, rainfall maps, forest distribution maps, industries maps etc.
