They were divided into many smaller clans under different chiefs. • In the western Himalaya lived the shepherd tribe of Gaddis. • The north-eastern part of the subcontinent too was entirely dominated by tribes-the Nagas, Ahoms and many others.
18	<p>Mention some special features of tribal societies.</p> <p>Some special features of tribal societies are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They did not follow the social rules and rituals which the Brahmanas prescribed. • They were not divided into many unequal classes. • Members of the society were united by kingship bonds.
19	<p>Write a brief note on the administrative system of the Gond Kingdom.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The administrative system of Gond kingdoms was centralized. • The Gond Kingdom was divided into garhs. • Each garh was controlled a particular Gond clan. • This was further divided into units of 84 villages called chaurasi. • The chaurasi was subdivided into barhots which were made up of 12 villages each.
