



An adverb usually qualifies a VERB, an ADJECTIVE or another ADVERB.



KINDS OF ADVERBS





ADVERB OF MANNER

Adverb of manner tells us how or in what manner an action is done. It answers the question how.

Example: The girl was playing happily.



ADVERB OF PLACE

Adverb of place tell us where or at what place an action takes place. An adverb of place answers the question where.

Example: He is sitting there.



ADVERB OF TIME

Adverb of time indicates the time of action and answers the question when.

Example: You must have gone for a walk early.



ADVERB OF DEGREE


Adverb of degree indicates the intensity of an action and answers the question how much.

Example: She nearly fell from the cliff.



Adverb of frequency indicates how often an action takes place and answers the question how often.

Example: We visit the Mishras often.
