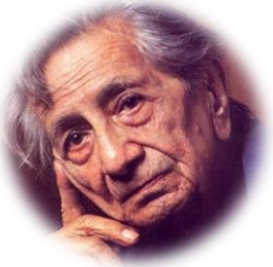

**Bhisham Sahni** was a Hindi writer, playwright and actor, most famous for his novel and television screenplay, *Tamas* (Darkness), a powerful and passionate account of the Partition of India. He was awarded the Padma Bhushan for literature in 1998 and the Sahitya Akademi Fellowship in 2002.

### Summary:
