Important concepts and value points of the story:

## Setting:

### > **Point of view**:

## **Conflict**:

It is the problem of a story. Conflict is the core or soul of a story. Stronger conflict makes better stories.

There are three types of conflicts.

- (a) Person versus person: The problem between or among the characters.
- (b) **Person versus self**:

This is an internal conflict. Here the conflict is between a person and his conscience.
