The happy dog ran quickly to the park.

Ans: The **happy** dog **ran** quickly to the **park**.

Neatness counts! 

1. The bright sun shines warmly over the valley.

Ans: bright (Adj), sun (N), shines (V), warmly (Adv), valley (N)

2. She runs quickly to catch the bus.

Ans: runs (V), quickly (Adv), bus (N)

3. The curious child asked a question.

Ans: curious (Adj), child (N), asked (V), question (N)

4. They played happily in the garden.

Ans: played (V), happily (Adv), garden (N)

5. The dog barked loudly at the stranger.

Ans: dog (N), barked (V), loudly (Adv), stranger (N)

6. He writes neatly in his notebook.

Ans: writes (V), neatly (Adv), notebook (N)

7. The athlete trained hard for the competition.

Ans: athlete (N), trained (V), hard (Adv), competition (N)

8. The stormy weather frightened the villagers.

Ans: stormy (Adj), weather (N), frightened (V), villagers (N)

9. The student studied diligently for the exam.


Ans: student (N), studied (V), diligently (Adv), exam (N)

10. The chef cooked a delicious meal.

Ans: chef (N), cooked (V), delicious (Adj), meal (N)
