What are Abstract Nouns?

Abstract Nouns are words that name things that we cannot see, touch or hold. In simple terms, Nouns that cannot be physically experienced by our five senses are **Abstract Nouns**. They are the opposite of **Concrete Nouns**.

E.g.: beauty, happiness, childhood, freedom

Abstract Nouns are usually formed by adding a suffix to nouns, verbs, or adjectives.
