THE PRESENT PERFECT TENSE

-The tense which is used to express actions completed in the recent past is known as the **PRESENT PERFECT TENSE.**

-Present Perfect Tense is a connection to the Present.

- We don't use the exact time expressions with the Present Perfect Tense.

- Adverbs like *never, ever, before* and *yet* can be used.

- The Present Perfect Tense is formed by using an auxiliary verb (has/have) + a main verb (in the past participle form)

THE PAST PERFECT TENSE

Past Perfect Tense is a verb tense used to talk about actions that were completed before some point in the past.

E.g. – I returned home because I **had forgotten** my notebook at home.

-They **had gone** out when you called.

E.g. – I **will have finished** my homework by dinner time.

- By next summer, they **will have built** the bridge.

Some of the time Expressions used with the Future Perfect Tense:

- Until/till... (mostly used in negative sentences)
- By the end of...
- By tomorrow...
