



ADVERBS

An adverb is a word that modifies a verb, an adjective, or another adverb by providing more information about how, when, where, or to what extent an action is performed.





KINDS OF ADVERBS	FUNCTION	EXAMPLES	EXAMPLE SENTENCE
Adverbs of Manner	It describes how or in	quickly, slowly,	She danced gracefully.
HOW?	what manner an action takes place.	neatly etc.	
Adverbs of Time When	It tells when an action takes place.	today, soon, etc.	He will call tomorrow.
Adverbs of Place	It shows where an action happens or occurs.	here, outside, everywhere etc.	They met here.
Adverbs of Frequency How often?	It shows how often or how many times an action happens.	always, rarely, sometimes etc.	She always eats breakfast.
Adverbs of Degree to what extent?	It expresses the strength or intensity of an action. It answers the questions 'How much?', 'How far?', and 'To what extent?'.	very, too, extremely etc.	He was too tired to continue.
