Ans-All the sea creatures welcome the child when he is born. The whale whistled, the porpoise rolled and the dolphins showed their backs.

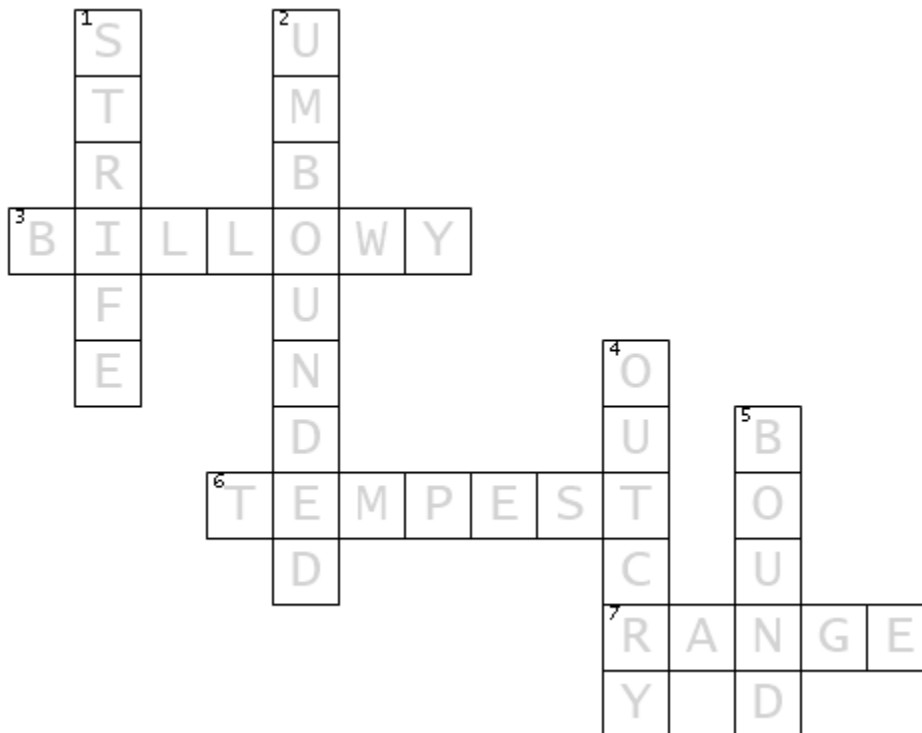
3. *'But never have sought, nor sighed for change;
