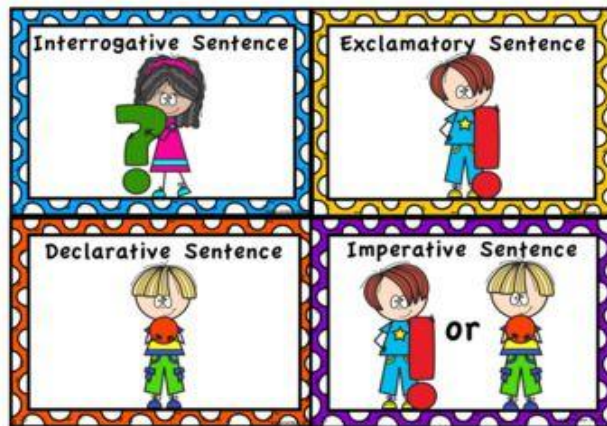

A sentence is a group of words that work together to express a complete thought. It usually starts with a capital letter, ends with punctuation like a period, question mark, or exclamation mark, and makes sense when you read it.



For example: The cat chased the mouse.

Based on the purpose of the sentence and the manner in which the thought is expressed, sentences are classified into:



1. Interrogative Sentences - Interrogative sentences are questions. They often start with a question word like *who*, *what*, *where*, *when*, *why*, or *how*.



Example: 1. Where do you live?
2. Why are you late today?

They can also begin with a helping verb for yes/no questions. They ask something and end with a question mark.

Example: Do you like playing soccer?

2. Exclamatory Sentences - An exclamatory sentence makes a statement (just like a declarative sentence), but it also conveys excitement and strong emotions. An exclamatory sentence ends with an exclamation mark.

Example: 1. What a beautiful day!
2. I'm really going to miss this place!

3. Declarative Sentences -A declarative sentence is a simple statement that is used to provide information about something or state a fact. It ends with a full stop or a period.

Example: 1. I love playing soccer.
2. The sun is shining.

4. Imperative Sentences – Imperative sentences are used to make a request, offer advice, issue a command, or give an instruction. They can end with a period or exclamation point.

Example: 1. Pass the ball to me.
2. Close the window.
3. Do not run out in front of that car!
