Preposition - A Preposition is a word placed before a Noun or a Pronoun to show its relation with other words in the sentence.

1. in – is used for months, years, decades, centuries and long periods of time.

Eg. in January, in the 1970s, in the evening, in the summer, etc.

2. on – is used for days and dates.

Eg. on Wednesday, on January, on 1st May, etc.

3. at – is used for precise time.

Eg. at 5 o'clock, at 10 a.m., at breakfast, at sunrise, etc.
