11	What are the functions of the District Collector? <b>The main functions of the District Collector are as follows: -</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Collector is in charge of the law and order of administration in the district.</b></li><li>• <b>He /She performs the supervisory role over the Police Administration.</b></li><li>• <b>He /She advises the Government on various aspects of law and order.</b></li><li>• <b>He is the pivotal figure in carrying out the developmental programmes.</b></li></ul>
