Preposition: Prepositions are words that are placed before a noun or a pronoun to show its position or relation with the other noun or a pronoun. Some of the prepositions are in, on, at, with, under, in between, above, in front of, among, over, through, of, behind, into, below and beside.

Preposition	Use of the Preposition
1) in	used for places, position, neighborhood, months, years etc.
2) on	used for streets, vehicles, large vehicles, days and dates etc.
3) at	tells relationships with specific points.
4) with	used when people and things are together.
5) under	used when a person or a thing is at a lower level.
6) between	used when to show that the person or thing is between two things.
7) among	used to show surrounded by somebody/something; in the middle or included in a larger group of people or things.
8) in front of	used when someone/something is in front of something or someone.
9) above	used to show something that is of high level.
10) over	used when something happens higher than the person, place or animal.
11) below	used when a person or a thing is at a lower level.
12) through	used to show something passing through anything.
13) behind	in the place or situation the is being or has been departed from.
14) into	used to talk about the movement of something.
15) beside	used by placing two nouns side by side.

Here, **with** is the preposition. It is placed before the noun fries and shows relationship between hamburgers and fries.

Some other prepositions are – *in, on, at, under, between, of, among, in front of, above, over, below, through, behind, into* and *beside.*


