Adverbs are words that modify verbs, adjectives, and other adverbs. They often tell us when, where, why, how often and under what condition something happens.

Rohit walked *quickly*. (modifying the verb *walked*)

Lata is a *very* good singer. (modifying the adjective *good*)

The taxi came *surprisingly* early. (modifying the adverb *early*)



Kinds of Adverbs:

Adverb of Manner	Tells us how something	We must not treat animals

Adverb of Place	Tells us where something	The children have gone

Adverb of Time	Tells us when something	The bus arrived an hour

Adverb of Frequency	Tells us how often an	I always tell her to work

Adverb of Degree	Tells us about the intensity	The report is absolutely

Adverbs of Frequency	always, usually, often, sometimes,

Adverbs of Degree	extremely, quite, almost, very, too
