Adverbs are words that modify verbs, adjectives, and other adverbs. They often tell us when, where, why, how often and under what condition something happens.

Rohit walked *quickly*. (modifying the verb *walked*)

Lata is a *very* good singer. (modifying the adjective *good*)

The taxi came *surprisingly* early. (modifying the adverb *early*)



### Kinds of Adverbs:

Kind of Adverb	Function	Example
<b>Adverb of Manner</b>	Tells us <b>how</b> something happens	We must not treat animals <b>cruelly</b> .
<b>Adverb of Place</b>	Tells us <b>where</b> something happens	The children have gone <b>out</b> .
<b>Adverb of Time</b>	Tells us <b>when</b> something happens	The bus arrived an hour <b>late</b> .
<b>Adverb of Frequency</b>	Tells us <b>how often</b> an action takes place	I <b>always</b> tell her to work harder.
<b>Adverb of Degree</b>	Tells us about the <b>intensity</b> or <b>degree</b> of an action or a quality.	The report is <b>absolutely</b> true.
