The term '**Preposition**' means 'a word that is positioned before' (*pre* means *before*). A preposition is a word placed before a noun or pronoun to show its relation with something else in the sentence. They are usually placed before their objects.

Eg: The apple is **in** a basket.

TYPES OF PREPOSITIONS:

1. **Prepositions of Place/ Position**- show **where** something is.

Eg: The cat is **under** the bed.

The book is **on** the table.

2. **Prepositions of Time**- show **when** something happens.

Eg: The meeting is **at** 9 a.m.

We went to the beach **on** Sunday.

3. **Prepositions of Direction**- show **movement**.

Eg: She is going **to** school.

The ball rolled **into** the pond.

4. **Prepositions of Agent**- show **who/ what** performs the action.

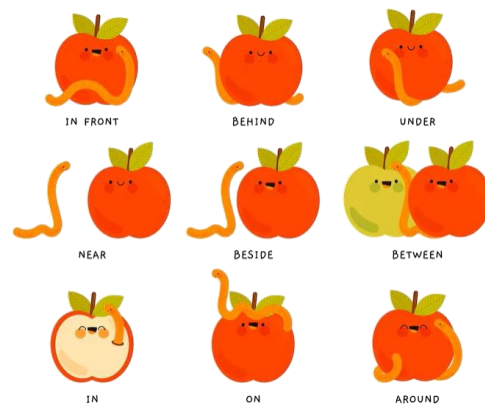
Eg: The poem was written **by** Shakespeare.

The door was opened **with** a key.

5. **Phrasal Prepositions**- Groups of words used like prepositions.

Eg: He came late **because of** the rain.

She stood **in front of** the mirror.
