The term '**Preposition**' means 'a word that is positioned before' (*pre* means *before*). A preposition is a word placed before a noun or pronoun to show its relation with something else in the sentence. They are usually placed before their objects.

Eg: The apple is **in** a basket.

TYPES OF PREPOSITIONS:

1. <u>Prepositions of Place/ Position</u>- show where something is.

Eg: The cat is **under** the bed. The book is **on** the table.

2. Prepositions of Time- show when something happens.

Eg: The meeting is **at** 9 a.m.

We went to the beach **on** Sunday.

3. Prepositions of Direction- show movement.

Eg: She is going **to** school.

The ball rolled **into** the pond.

4. Prepositions of Agent- show who/ what performs the action.


Eg: The poem was written by Shakespeare.

The door was opened with a key.

5. Phrasal Prepositions Groups of words used like prepositions.

Eg: He came late because of the rain.

She stood **in front of** the mirror.
