A Common Noun is a name given in common to a person, place animal or a thing. It does not have a specific name. Common nouns are not capitalized unless they are used in the beginning of a sentence.

Example: People: mother, father, baby, child, toddler, teenager, grandmother, student, teacher, minister, woman, man

Animals: lion, tiger, bear, dog, cat, alligator, cricket, bird, wolf

Things: table, truck, book, pencil, iPad, computer, coat, boots,

Places: city, state, country, continent, coffee shop, restaurant, park, zoo
