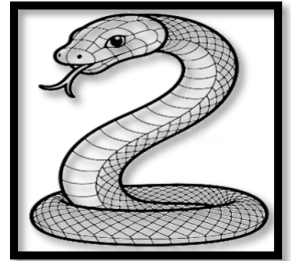

b. Give two disadvantages of sowing seeds by hands.

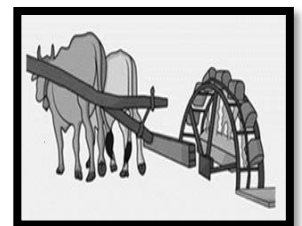


3. The farmer guided his bull to turn the Persian wheel beside the well. Slowly, the water began to flow into the fields, helping the crops grow strong and healthy.
