Non-finite: to go, hiking

Finite: left

Non-finite: having completed

3. We watched the sun setting over the horizon.

Finite: watched Non-finite: setting

4. Running every day keeps him fit.

Finite: keeps

**Non-finite: running** 

5. They decided to postpone the meeting.

Finite: decided

Non-finite: to postpone
6. She loves to paint landscapes.

**Finite: loves** 

Non-finite: to paint

7. The children stopped playing in the park.

Finite: stopped
Non-finite: playing

8. He went to the store to buy groceries.

Finite: went Non-finite: to buy

9. We saw her dancing at the party.

Finite: saw

**Non-finite: dancing** 

10. The teacher encouraged the students to study harder.

Finite: encouraged Non-finite: to study
