

26	<p>Define 'plateau' and give its importance.</p> <p>A plateau is a landform that rises up from the surrounding land and has a more or less flat surface.</p> <p>Importance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plateaus are rich in mineral deposits. • They have been called the store houses of minerals.
27	<p>What are mountain forests, and where are they commonly found?</p> <p>Mountain forests are the types of forests found in the mountainous regions, characterized by coniferous trees like pines and firs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ These forests are commonly found in the Himalayas and other high-altitude areas around the world. ➤ At higher altitudes only grasses, mosses and lichens are found.
28	<p>Write a note on 'Desert'.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deserts are considered to be large and dry expanses with very little precipitation. • Their flora and fauna are also unique. • Some deserts are hot, like the Sahara Desert in Africa or the Thar Desert in the northwest of the Indian Subcontinent. • Others are cold, like the Gobi Desert in Asia.
