We use 'is' when we talk about one person or thing and for words like – This, That, He, She and It.

For example –

1. This **is** a boy.
2. That **is** a house.
3. He **is** my best friend.
4. She **is** playing with her doll.
5. It **is** a sunny day.

We use 'are' when we talk about more than one person or thing and for words like – These, Those, You, We and They.

For example –

1. These **are** my books.
2. Those **are** your shoes.
3. You **are** very kind.
4. We **are** going to the park.
5. They **are** playing football.

We use 'Has' for the following words: He, She, It and for the name of person or a thing.

For example –

1. He **has** a red bicycle.
2. She **has** a beautiful voice.
3. It **has** a long tail.
4. Riya **has** a storybook.
5. The lion **has** sharp teeth.

We use 'Have' for the following words: I, You, We, They and for names of more than one person and thing.

For example –

1. I **have** two brothers.
2. You **have** neat handwriting.
3. We **have** new uniforms.
4. They **have** a garden at home.
5. Aman and Priya **have** art class today.
