PARAGRAPH WRITING

A paragraph is a short composition or an ordered group of sentences dealing with an idea or a theme. The sentences in a paragraph are logically connected to each other. A paragraph conveys the writer's views on a given topic or idea.

Features of a Paragraph:

- A paragraph has a title.
- All the sentences in a paragraph must relate to the topic.
- The beginning sentence is usually a key sentence.
- The other sentences must follow a logical order.
- The final sentence usually concludes the paragraph.
- The writing should be simple and lucid.

The structure of a Paragraph:

Topic Sentence

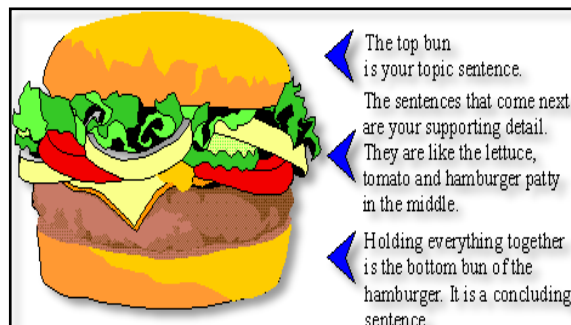
The topic sentence is the sentence that lays out a preview of what the paragraph will be about. It puts the reader's mindset into the right place to digest the information.

Supporting Sentence

The supporting sentence is the most important part of the paragraph and provides details to support the topic sentence.

Concluding Sentence

The concluding sentence wraps up the paragraph and ties back to the topic sentence. A conclusion could be a reiteration of the topic, an opinion based on the topic, or a way to wrap up the paragraph with a more general statement.



Types of Paragraphs:

The 4 types of paragraphs are:

A **narrative paragraph** tells a story of a certain event.

A **descriptive paragraph** gives details about a person, place thing or idea.

An **expository paragraph** explains something, gives directions or shows how something happens and a **persuasive paragraph** is opinionated and tries to sway the reader.
