In olden days, there was no money. People exchanged their goods with each other. This was called BARTER SYSYTEM.

In modern days, we have money in the form of paper (notes), metal (coins) and plastic (cards). The notes and coins we use are called Currency. The currency of India is called Indian rupee (INR) symbol - ₹ The currency of Oman is called Omani Rial (OMR/RO) symbol- .ع.

Children get pocket money from their parents or elders. Raj and Hamed are two boys. Hamed is Raj's friend. They get a pocket money every month. Hamed lives in Muscat, he gets $5 . \varepsilon . J$ as a pocket money. Whereas Raj lives in Delhi and he gets 500 ₹.
