Money, Money, Everywhere!

Money helps us buy things we need and want. People earn (to get paid for work done) money by working at all different kinds of jobs. For example: carpenter, doctor, barber, nurse, teacher, fireman and janitor.

If you have money, you can use it for many things. You can pay bills. You can buy things from malls or shops. You can save it in the bank.

In olden days, there was no money. People exchanged their goods with each other. This was called **BARTER SYSYTEM**.

In modern days, we have money in the form of paper (notes), metal (coins) and plastic (cards). The notes and coins we use are called Currency. The currency of India is called Indian rupee (INR) symbol - ₹ The currency of Oman is called Omani Rial (OMR/RO) symbol - .٤.)

Children get pocket money from their parents or elders. Raj and Hamed are two boys. Hamed is Raj's friend. They get a pocket money every month. Hamed lives in Muscat, he gets 5 .€. as a pocket money.

Whereas Raj lives in Delhi and he gets 500 ₹.
