SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

In every sentence, we have two main parts:

1. **Subject:** The part of the sentence that tells us *who* or *what* the sentence is about.
2. **Predicate:** The part of the sentence that tells us *what the subject does* or *what happens to the subject*.

Examples:

- **The cat** (subject) **is sleeping on the couch** (predicate).
- **My friends and I** (subject) **went to the amusement park yesterday** (predicate).
