1	<p>How are forests important for us?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Forests play a vital role in the life of human beings.❖ Plants release oxygen that we breathe and absorb carbon dioxide.❖ The roots of the plants bind the soil and in this way check soil erosion.❖ We get several things from the forests, such as wood for furniture, fuel, fodder, medicinal herbs, honey, lac, gum, fruits etc.❖ Forests provide natural habitat to wildlife, such as lions, tigers, elephants, monkeys, etc.
