Preposition: Prepositions are words that are placed before a noun or a pronoun to show its position or relation with the other noun or a pronoun.

Some of the prepositions are - ***in, on, at, with, under*** and ***between***

Preposition	Use of Prepositions
1) on	<i>Used when there is a surface involved and to specify days and dates.</i> It is used for streets, large vehicles. E.g.: The man is sitting on the chair. I am travelling on a ship.
2) in	<i>used to indicate location or position within or inside something</i> It is used for places, position, neighborhood, months and years. E.g.: I live in Muscat. The books are in the bag.
3) at	<i>used to indicate a specific time, place, address and an activity.</i> E.g.: Rohit is at the hospital. The movie will begin at 6:00 pm.
4) with	<i>used when people and things are together.</i> E.g.: Tina went to the market with her father.
5) between	<i>used to show that the person or thing is between (middle of) two things/persons.</i> E.g.: Sam stood between his father and mother.
6) under	<i>used when a person or a thing is at a lower level than something else.</i> E.g.: The rat is under the chair.

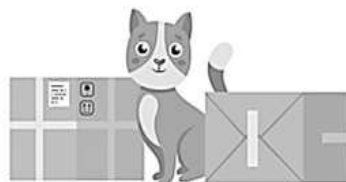

Preposition: Prepositions are words that are placed before a noun or a pronoun to show its position or relation with the other noun or a pronoun.

Some more prepositions are - ***in front of, behind, to, from*** and ***near***.

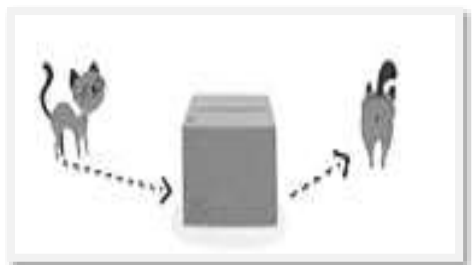
Preposition	Use of the Preposition
7) behind	<i>used to indicate at the back of someone or something.</i> E.g.: The boy is hiding behind the tree.
8) in front of	<i>used when someone/something is in front of something or someone else.</i> E.g.: The cow is in front of the shed.
9) to	<i>used to indicate a destination, a direction and a receiver of an action.</i> E.g.: Tom is going to the park.
10) from	<i>used to talk about origins, sources, starting points, distance and to express a reason.</i> E.g.: Paper is made from trees.
11) near	<i>used to indicate 'not far away' in distance.</i> E.g.: Tiya is sleeping near her grandmother.
