Choose the correct verb from the brackets.

- The furniture in the new classroom **looks** beautifully arranged.
- The team **are** discussing their individual strategies before the competition. (*The members are acting individually.*)
- One of the boys **plays** the piano very well.
- The students, as well as their teacher, **are** planning a field trip.
- The teacher and the coordinator **attend** the meeting.
- Two-thirds of the work **has** already been completed.

Exercise 2: Error Detection and Correction

Directions: Read the following sentences carefully. Identify whether each sentence is correct or incorrect. If the sentence is incorrect, rewrite it with the correct verb.

- Incorrect**
Correction: Both of us **have** enormous potential to succeed in life.
(*Both is always plural and takes a plural verb.*)
- Incorrect**
Correction: The number of applicants **has** increased significantly this year.
(*The number of + plural noun takes a singular verb.*)

3. **Incorrect**

Correction: A number of applicants **are** waiting outside the office.
(A number of + plural noun means "many/several" and takes a plural verb.)

4. **Incorrect**

Correction: Every student and every teacher **is** required to attend the orientation.
(Subjects beginning with every are treated as singular.)

5. **Incorrect**

Correction: None of the information **is** useful.
(Information is an uncountable noun and takes a singular verb.)
