<b>CONJUNCTION</b>	<b>FUNCTION</b>	<b>EXAMPLE</b>
<b>and</b>	used to add an idea to another	I play soccer and tennis.
<b>nor</b>	to join two negative ideas together	I do not relish the fish, nor the chicken.
<b>or</b>	it is used to show choices	Would you like to drink milk, or coffee?
<b>because</b>	used to show a reason for a particular action	Tom was absent, because he was unwell.
<b>if</b>	used when there is a condition to be met	Mother will buy me a new bicycle, if I study well.
<b>until</b>	to indicate that an event happens only up to a certain point of time	Please do not leave, until I return.
<b>so</b>	used to show the result/effect of something	Father was too tired, so he rested for a while.
<b>yet</b>	to join two contrasting ideas	He is poor yet generous.
