gives information about the distribution of different age groups of people based on gender. The shape of the age-sex pyramid of a country is indicative of a lot of information about the country. T size towards the bottom may be used to estimate the birth rate, while the size towards the top to estimate the death rate. A population pyramid in which the base is broad and the top part is narro means that although a large amount of births take place, not all grow up to be adults and old; it	
means many die before reaching these ages.
