A sentence is a group of words that work together to express a complete thought. It usually starts with a capital letter, ends with punctuation like a period, question mark, or exclamation mark, and makes sense when you read it.

For example: Tom and Mary are friends.

Based on the purpose of the sentence and the manner in which the thought is expressed, sentences are classified into:



- 1. Interrogative Sentences** - Interrogative sentences are questions. They often start with a question word like *who, what, where, when, why, or how*.

**Example:** 1. What is your name?  
2. When is your birthday?



They can also begin with a helping verb for yes/no questions. They ask something and end with a question mark.

**Example:** Did you call me yesterday?



- 2. Exclamatory Sentences** - An exclamatory sentence makes a statement (just like a declarative sentence), but it also conveys excitement and strong emotions. An exclamatory sentence ends with an exclamation mark.

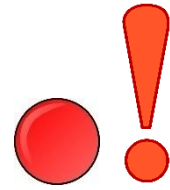
**Example:** 1. What a fantastic performance!  
2. I miss you!

- 3. Declarative Sentences** - A declarative sentence is a simple statement that is used to provide information about something or state a fact. It ends with a full stop or a period.



- Example:** 1. I love painting.  
2. The students are going for a picnic this month.

**4. Imperative Sentences** – Imperative sentences are used to make a request, offer advice, issue a command, or give an instruction. They can end with a period or exclamation point.



- Example:** 1. Push the red button.  
2. Close the door.  
3. Do not talk!
