

- ❖ If an imaginary line is drawn joining the "pointer stars" of the Saptarishi and extended further, it will point to the Pole Star.
- 18 Write short note on the 'Moon'.
 - **❖** The moon is the only natural satellite of our planet earth.
 - Its diameter is just about a quarter of the earth's diameter.
 - It is comparatively closer to earth than all other celestial bodies.
 - ❖ It does not support life.
 - It revolves around the earth and rotates about its own axis in about the same time, due to which only one side of the moon is visible to us.
