



Story Writing

A Story is a work of fiction or imagination that is usually written in easily understandable grammatical structure with natural flow of speech. Story writing is an art. It is the oldest form of written composition. It is a work of imagination that is written in an easily understandable grammatical structure.



Format of the story:



TITLE OF THE STORY

SPACE

PARAGRAPH 1

SPACE

(set up the action/plot, gives background of the story or builds in a way that grabs the attention.)

• The introduction or beginning of the story

PARAGRAPH 2

PARAGRAPH 3

SPACE

• Incidents and events are explained in detail (logically presented in a sequential manner)

• Conclusion (climax- happy or sad ending)

SPACE

MORAL/ WORDS OF WISDOM/ QUOTE

POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. Give a suitable title and it should be as short as possible.
- 2. Introduce the main character and setting (time and location) in the beginning.
- 3. Develop suspense and action through a sequence of events in chronological order (with a clear beginning, middle and end).
- 4. Introduce monologue, dialogue or conversation (at least 3) in the story; but be careful to make it interesting and natural.
- 5. Provide a suitable moral in the end.


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6. Use past tense while writing the story.
