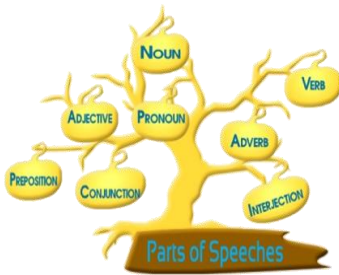

PARTS of Speech



Parts of speech are the basic “building blocks” of English. Every word we use belongs to a group that shows how it works in a sentence. These groups are called *parts of speech*. For example, some words name things (*nouns*), some show action (*verbs*), and others describe (*adjectives* or *adverbs*).

In short: Parts of speech tell us the role each word plays in making our sentences clear and meaningful.
