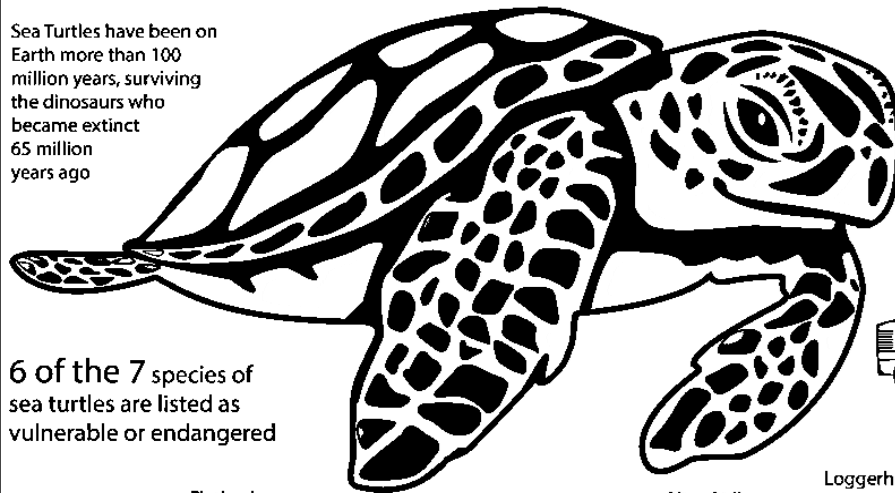

Sea Turtles have been on Earth more than 100 million years, surviving the dinosaurs who became extinct 65 million years ago

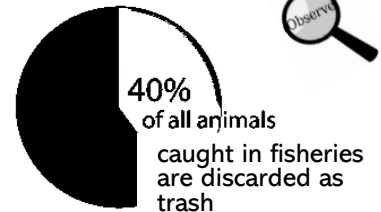
6 of the 7 species of sea turtles are listed as vulnerable or endangered
