POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

A Possessive Pronoun is a pronoun which is used to show, indicate possession or ownership.

PERSONAL PRONOUNS	POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS
I	mine
you	yours
he	his
she	hers
it	its
we	ours
you	yours
they	theirs

Example 1:

• This pen is **my pen**, not **your pen**.



• This pen is **mine**, not **yours**.

Example 2:

- He offered to swap his camera for **her camera**.
- He offered to swap his camera for hers.
