- b) Why does the person being spoken about have such a look on his face?

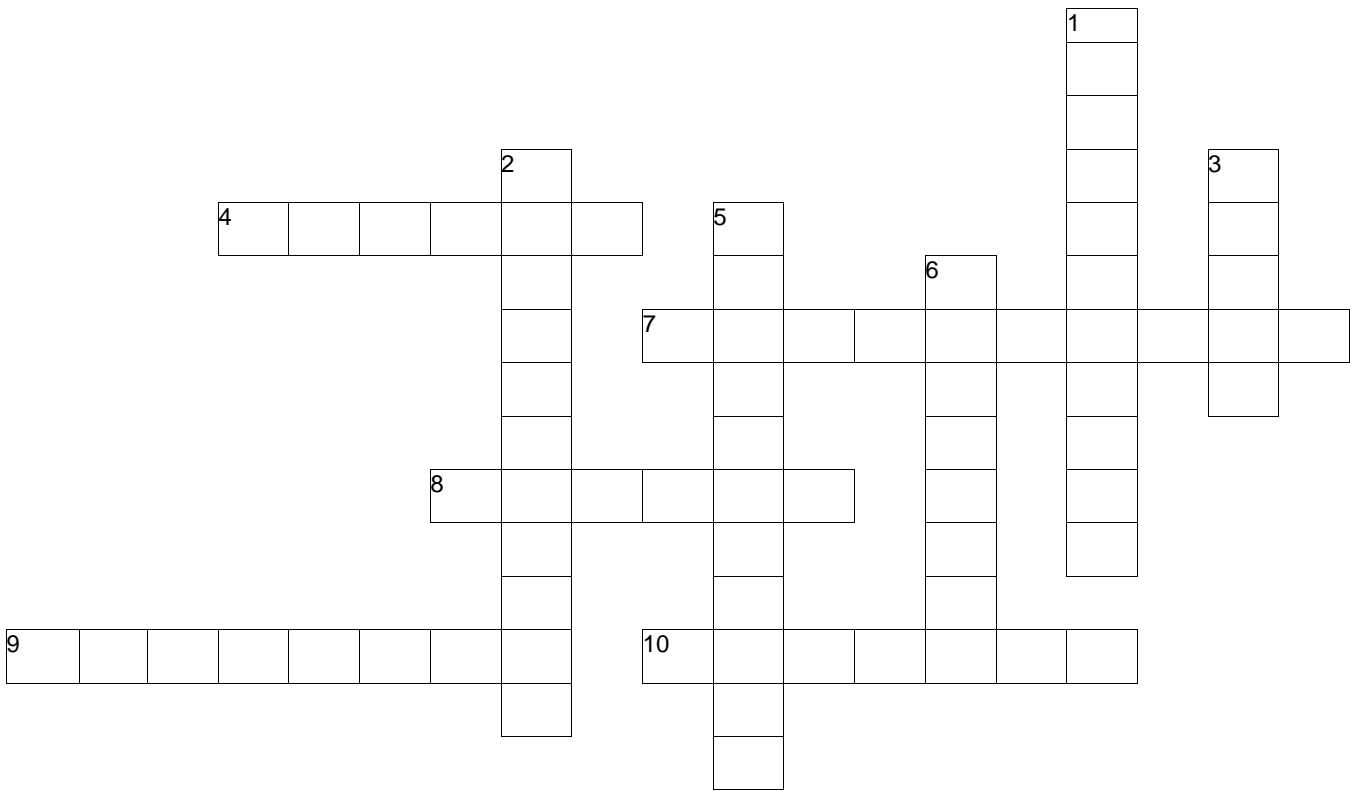
