- c) How do they welcome him?

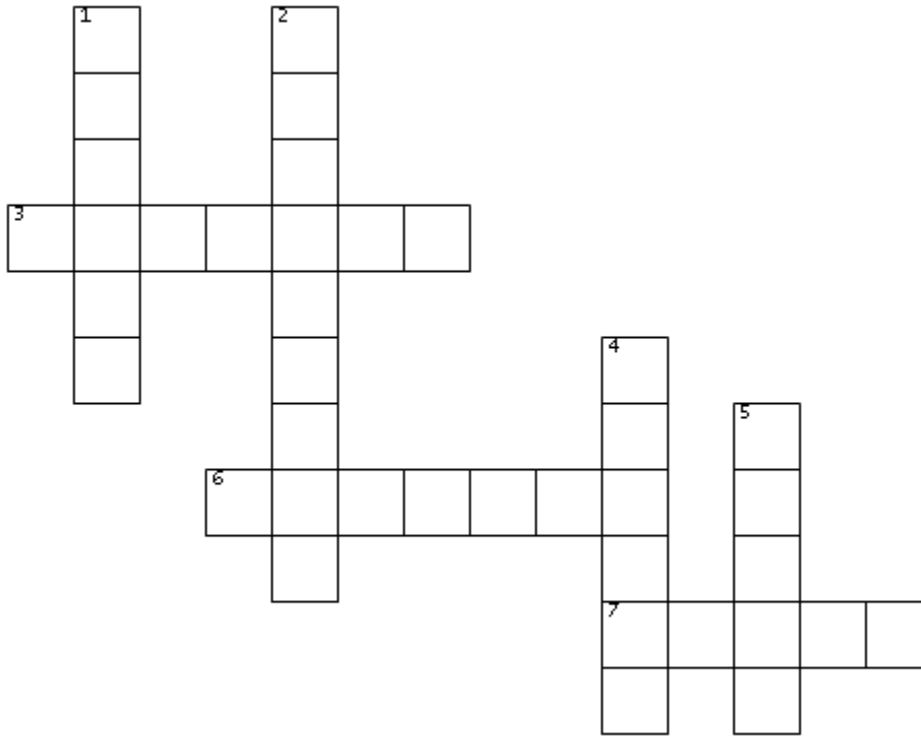
3. *'But never have sought, nor sighed for change;*
